DANGEROUS GOODS SAFETY ACT 2004

EXEMPTION NOTICE NO. 74

Made by the Chief Dangerous Goods Officer.

Pursuant to section 22 of the *Dangerous Goods Safety Act 2004* ("Act"), I hereby exempt holders of a Western Australia fireworks contractor licence from the need to hold an explosives transport licence for the transport of fireworks on water as required by Regulation 97(2) of the *Dangerous Goods Safety (Explosives) Regulations 2007*.

Conditions of exemption

- This exemption only applies to fireworks that are being transported by water for the purpose of conducting a fireworks display under a fireworks event permit.
- The safety management of transporting the fireworks on water must be detailed in the contractor's Explosives Management Plan (EMP).

Period of exemption

This exemption expires on 31 October 2022, or when regulatory amendments make this exemption obsolete, or when amended or cancelled pursuant to Section 22(4) of the Act, whichever comes first.
