#### BIOSECURITY AND AGRICULTURE MANAGEMENT REGULATIONS 2013

#### QUARANTINE AREA AMENDMENT NOTICE

#### Fremantle

#### Red Imported Fire-Ant (*Solenopsis invicta*)

1. In accordance with regulation 60 of the *Biosecurity and Agriculture Management Regulations 2013* (BAM Regulations) a Quarantine Area Notice (QAN) relating to the declared pest Red Imported Fire-Ant *Solenopsis invicta* (RIFA) was published in the *Gazette* on 3 December 2019, in the West Australian newspaper on 5 December 2019 and on the website of the Department of Primary Industries and Regional Development (DPIRD).

2. In accordance with regulation 61 of the BAM Regulations, that QAN was amended by Quarantine Area Amendment Notice published in the *Gazette* on 20 May 2020.

3. Under regulation 61 of the BAM Regulations, the QAN is further amended by—

- (i) deleting in clause 1 “until 4 December 2020” and substituting “until 4 June 2021”; and
- (ii) deleting in clause 1 “Coast line of Rous Head south from Port Beach, coast line of Rous Head with the Inner Harbour, Queen Victoria Street, coast line of Fremantle and South Fremantle until South Fremantle Dog Beach, west side Marine Terrace, north side of South Street, west side of South Terrace, north side of Douglas street, west side of Carnac Street, north side of Wray Avenue, west side of Hampton Road, north side of Stevens Street, west side of Swanbourne Street (including Stevens Reserve), west side of East Street, north and south side of Beach Street (including North Worrall Park and East Street Jetty), west side Queen Victoria Street, south side of Tydeman Road, west side Port Beach Road and Port Beach” and substituting “Coast line of Rous Head north-east from North Mole lighthouse to Port Beach, west side of Port Beach Road, south side of Tydeman Road, west side of Queen Victoria Street to north side of Queen Victoria Street bridge, and north-west of the Inner Harbour high water line to North Mole lighthouse”.
