### LOCAL GOVERNMENT ACT 1995

*City of Melville*

#### STREET NUMBERING AMENDMENT LOCAL LAW 2021

Under the powers conferred by the *Local Government Act 1995*, and all other powers enabling it, the Council of the City of Melville resolved on 16 March 2021 to make the following local law.

**1. Citation**

This local law may be cited as the *City of Melville Street Numbering Amendment Local Law 2021*.

**2. Commencement**

This local law comes into operation 14 days after the day of its publication in the *Government Gazette*.

**3. Principal Local Law amended**

This local law amends the *City of Melville Local Law Relating to Street Numbering 2006* as published in the *Government Gazette* on 21 April 2006.

**4. References to the City of Melville**

In each place where it appears in this local law, replace the term “Local Government” with “local government”.

**5. Clause 1 amended**

Clause 1 is amended as follows—

- (a) For all defined terms, italicise the term and delete the quotation marks around it.

- (b) Delete the current definition of *lot* and replace with the following definition—  
*lot* means—
- (a) a lot as defined in and for the purposes of the *Planning and Development Act 2005*; or
  - (b) a lot in a strata scheme as defined in and for the purposes of the *Strata Titles Act 1985*; or
  - (c) a lot in a survey-strata scheme as defined in and for the purposes of the *Strata Titles Act 1985*.
- (c) In the definition of *residential lot* delete the word “Town” and replace with the word “Local”.

#### 6. Clause 2 amended

Clause 2 is amended as follows—

- (a) In subclause 2.1, delete the words “in accordance with its policy on street numbering”.
- (b) After subclause 2.1 insert—  
 2.1A The local government will allocate to each lot a street number relating to the street from which the primary access to the lot is gained.

#### 7. Clause 3 amended

In subclause 3.2, delete the words “Local Law” and replace with “local law”.

#### 8. Clause 5 amended

Clause 5 is amended as follows—

- (a) In subclause 5.1, after the word “may” insert the phrase “, under section 3.25 of the *Local Government Act 1995*,”.
- (b) In subclause 5.2(a), delete the words “Local Law” and replace with “local law”.

#### 9. New clause 5A inserted

The following new clause is inserted after clause 5—

##### 5A Objection and appeal rights

Part 9 Division 1 of the *Local Government Act 1995* applies to a decision under subclause 5.1 of this local law.

#### 10. Clause 7 amended

- (a) In subclause 7.2, delete the word “clause” and replace with “subclause”.
- (b) In subclause 7.3, delete the word “authorized” and replace with “authorised”.

#### 11. Schedule 1 replaced

Delete Schedule 1 and replace it with the following Schedule—

Racing Bets Levy Act 2009

### **Racing Bets Levy Amendment Regulations 2021**

**2. Commencement**

**3. Regulations amended**

**4. Regulation 6 amended**

Before regulation 6(1) insert:

- (1A) This regulation does not apply in respect of betting exchange bets placed or accepted on a race meeting occurring on or after 1 May 2021.

Note: The heading to amended regulation 6 is to read:

**Levy amount: bets (other than certain betting exchange bets) placed or accepted on or after 1 August 2018**

**5. Regulation 7 inserted**

After regulation 6 insert:

**7. Levy amount: betting exchange bets placed or accepted on or after 1 May 2021**

- (1) The amount by way of levy to be paid under the *Betting Control Act 1954* section 14A(2) by a betting operator in respect of betting exchange bets placed or accepted on a race meeting occurring on or after 1 May 2021 is set out in this regulation.
- (2) The amount is 1% of turnover for each month beginning with May 2021 unless subregulation (3) or (4) applies.
- (3) If turnover (calculated from the beginning of the racing year) reaches \$3 000 000, the amount is 31.8% of gross revenue for each month, or part of a month, after turnover reaches \$3 000 000.
- (4) No amount is payable for any month during which turnover does not reach \$1 000.

**Road Traffic (Vehicles) Amendment Regulations  
(No. 4) 2021****SL 2021/37**

**1. Citation**

These regulations are the *Road Traffic (Vehicles) Amendment Regulations (No. 4) 2021*.

**2. Commencement**

These regulations come into operation as follows —

- (a) regulations 1 and 2 — on the day on which these regulations are published in the *Gazette*;
- (b) the rest of the regulations — on the day after that day.

**3. Regulations amended**

These regulations amend the *Road Traffic (Vehicles) Regulations 2014*.

**4. Regulation 3 amended**

In regulation 3 insert in alphabetical order:

*street rod vehicle* means a vehicle that has been modified for safe road use and that —

- (a) has a body and frame that were built before 1949; or
- (b) is a replica of a vehicle the body and frame of which were built before 1949;

**5. Regulation 84 amended**

In regulation 84 delete “vehicle licence fee” and insert:

vehicle licence charge

**6. Regulation 84A inserted**

After regulation 84 insert:

**84A. Classic vehicles**

(1) In this regulation —

*approved motoring organisation* means a body corporate approved under subregulation (4);

*classic vehicle* means a vehicle that is —

- (a) a street rod vehicle; or
- (b) a vehicle manufactured before 1990;

*discount period* means the period for which a reduced charge is paid;

*financial member*, of an approved motoring organisation, means a person who pays a membership fee to belong to the organisation;

*motoring event* means an event —

- (a) held by an approved motoring organisation; or
- (b) held by another person and approved by an approved motoring organisation;

*reduced charge* means a vehicle licence charge reduced in accordance with subregulation (2).

(2) The vehicle licence charge that, but for this regulation, would be payable for a classic vehicle is reduced by 75% if —

- (a) the vehicle is a light vehicle; and
- (b) the vehicle is owned by —
  - (i) an approved motoring organisation; or
  - (ii) a person who the CEO is satisfied will be a financial member of an approved motoring organisation for the duration of the discount period;

and

- (c) the CEO is satisfied the vehicle will not be used —
  - (i) at motoring events on more than 60 days in a calendar year in which the whole or a part of the discount period occurs; and
  - (ii) for other purposes (including for testing, maintenance or repair) on more than 30 days in a calendar year in which the whole or a part of the discount period occurs.

- (3) A classic vehicle is not used on a day for the purposes of subregulation (2)(c)(ii) if the vehicle is only driven by a repairer of the vehicle within a 5 km radius of the place where the vehicle is tested, maintained or repaired.
- (4) The CEO may approve a body corporate as an approved motoring organisation if the CEO is satisfied that the body corporate's operations include offering membership to persons who own classic vehicles.
- (5) The CEO may approve a label to be displayed on a classic vehicle for which a reduced charge is paid.
- (6) An owner of a classic vehicle who pays a reduced charge for the vehicle must ensure that, for the duration of the discount period, any label approved by the CEO under subregulation (5) is —
  - (a) displayed in a conspicuous place on the vehicle; and
  - (b) unobscured.

Penalty for this subregulation: a fine of 10 PU.

Modified penalty for this subregulation: 4 PU.

vehicle licence charge

**8. Regulation 226 amended**

In regulation 226 delete the definition of *street rod vehicle*.
