4. Change in number of councillors

- (1) This clause applies for the purposes of section 2.18A(1)(a) of the Act.
- (2) On and from next election day, the number of offices of councillor that the council of the Shire of Harvey is to have is 10.
- (3) On and from subsequent election day, the number of offices of councillor that the council of the Shire of Harvey is to have is 8.

Notes for this clause:

1. The provisions of this clause are made in consequence of the estimate of the district of Harvey's population specified in the *Local Government (Population Estimates) Order 2023*.
2. The effect of this clause is to decrease the number of offices of councillor that the council of the Shire of Harvey is to have from 13 to 8, which will be the maximum number of offices of councillor permitted for that council under section 2.17(4)(b) of the Act.
3. The decrease in the number of offices of councillor takes effect in 2 parts, the first part under subclause (2) on next election day and the second part under subclause (3) on subsequent election day — see section 2.18A(4) of the Act.
4. In accordance with section 2.18A(5) of the Act, the part decrease under subclause (2) has effect despite section 2.17(4)(b) of the Act.

5. Consequential directions

- (1) In order to give effect to clause 4(2) —
 - (a) Part 4 of the Act applies to preparing for and conducting any ordinary election for which next election day is the ordinary election day as if the changes effected by clause 4(2) take effect on commencement day; and

Local Government (Kalamunda - Change to Wards) Order 2023

Made by the Governor in Executive Council.

1. Citation

This order is the *Local Government (Kalamunda - Change to Wards) Order 2023*.

2. Commencement

This order comes into operation as follows —

- (a) clauses 1 and 2 — on the day on which this order is published in the *Gazette*;
- (b) the rest of the order — on the day after that day.

3. Terms used

In this order —

Authority means the Western Australian Land Information Authority established by the *Land Information Authority Act 2006* section 5(1);

commencement day means the day on which clause 4 comes into operation;

Deposited Plan, followed by a number, means the deposited plan of that number —

- (a) lodged with the Authority; and
- (b) certified by an authorised land officer as defined in the *Land Administration Act 1997* section 3(1); and

(c) available —

- (i) in paper form at the Authority's head office; and
- (ii) in electronic form on the Authority's official website;

next election means the first ordinary election for the City of Kalamunda held after commencement day;

next election day means the day fixed for the holding of the poll for the next election.

4. Ward boundaries changed

- (1) On next election day, the boundaries of the North Ward in the district of Kalamunda are changed so that the ward consists of the land delineated in red and coloured blue on Deposited Plan 426264 version 1.
- (2) On next election day, the boundaries of the North West Ward in the district of Kalamunda are changed so that the ward consists of the land delineated in red and coloured yellow on Deposited Plan 426264 version 1.

5. Change in number of councillors

- (1) On and from next election day, the number of offices of councillor for the North Ward on the council of the City of Kalamunda is 2.
- (2) On and from next election day, the number of offices of councillor for the North West Ward on the council of the City of Kalamunda is 2.
- (3) On and from next election day, the number of offices of councillor for the South East Ward on the council of the City of Kalamunda is 2.

Local Government (Kalamunda - Change to Wards) Order 2023

- (4) On and from next election day, the number of offices of councillor for the South West Ward on the council of the City of Kalamunda is 2.

6. Consequential directions

- (1) This clause applies for the purposes of giving effect to clauses 4 and 5.
- (2) Part 4 of the Act applies to preparing for and conducting the next election as if the changes effected by clauses 4 and 5 take effect on commencement day.
- (3) There is to be no election to fill the following offices of councillor —
- (a) the office of councillor that became vacant for the North Ward in February 2023;
 - (b) the office of councillor that became vacant for the South West Ward in April 2023.
- (4) The next election is to be —
- (a) in relation to the North Ward — for 1 office of councillor for a term ending in 2027; and
 - (b) in relation to the South East Ward — for 1 office of councillor for a term ending in 2027; and
 - (c) in relation to the South West Ward — for 2 offices of councillor, 1 for a term ending in 2025 and 1 for a term ending in 2027.
- (5) At the first ordinary election for the City of Kalamunda held after next election day, the returning officer must fix terms of office for councillors elected at that election for the North West Ward so that —
- (a) 1 councillor for the North West Ward will retire in 2029; and
 - (b) any other councillor for the North West Ward will retire in 2027.

This order is the *Local Government (Kalgoorlie-Boulder) Change Order 2023*.

2. Commencement

- (a) clauses 1 and 2 — on the day on which this order is published in the *Gazette*;
- (b) the rest of the order — on the day after that day.

3. Terms used

- (1) In this order —
 - commencement day* means the day on which clause 4 comes into operation;
 - next election day* means the first ordinary election day for the City of Kalgoorlie-Boulder that falls after commencement day;
 - ordinary election* means an ordinary election for the City of Kalgoorlie-Boulder.
- (2) If a term used in this order is given a meaning in section 2.16A of the Act, it has the same meaning in this order.

4. Change in number of councillors

For the purposes of section 2.18A(1)(a) of the Act, on and from next election day, the number of offices of councillor that the council of the City of Kalgoorlie-Boulder is to have is 8.

Notes for this clause:

1. The provision of this clause is made in consequence of the estimate of the district of Kalgoorlie-Boulder's population specified in the *Local Government (Population Estimates) Order 2023*.
2. The effect of this clause is to decrease on next election day the number of offices of councillor that the council of the City of Kalgoorlie-Boulder is to have from 12 to 8, which will be the maximum number of offices of councillor permitted for that council under section 2.17(4)(b) of the Act.

5. Terms of all councillors to end

For the purposes of section 2.18A(8) of the Act, the Act applies as if the Table to section 2.28 of the Act provided for the terms of all councillors on the council of the City of Kalgoorlie-Boulder to end on next election day.

Note for this clause:

In accordance with section 2.18A(9) of the Act, an ordinary election is to be held for the purpose of filling all offices of councillor on the council of the City of Kalgoorlie-Boulder (which under clause 4 will be 8 offices).

6. Consequential directions

In order to give effect to clauses 4 and 5 —

- (a) Part 4 of the Act applies to preparing for and conducting any ordinary election for which next election day is the ordinary election day as if the changes effected by clause 4 take effect on commencement day; and
- (b) the operation of Part 4 of the Act is modified to the extent necessary for the purposes of paragraph (a).

subsequent election day means the first ordinary election day for the City of Karratha that falls after next election day.

- (2) If a term used in this order is given a meaning in section 2.16A of the Act, it has the same meaning in this order.

- (1) This clause applies for the purposes of section 2.18A(1)(a) of the Act.
- (2) On and from next election day, the number of offices of councillor that the council of the City of Karratha is to have is 9.
- (3) On and from subsequent election day, the number of offices of councillor that the council of the City of Karratha is to have is 8.

Notes for this clause:

1. The provisions of this clause are made in consequence of the estimate of the district of Karratha's population specified in the *Local Government (Population Estimates) Order 2023*.
2. The effect of this clause is to decrease the number of offices of councillor that the council of the City of Karratha is to have from 11 to 8, which will be the maximum number of offices of councillor permitted for that council under section 2.17(4)(b) of the Act.
3. The decrease in the number of offices of councillor takes effect in 2 parts, the first part under subclause (2) on next election day and the second part under subclause (3) on subsequent election day — see section 2.18A(4) of the Act.
4. In accordance with section 2.18A(5) of the Act, the part decrease under subclause (2) has effect despite section 2.17(4)(b) of the Act.

5. Wards abolished

For the purposes of section 2.18A(7) of the Act, on next election day, all wards in the district of Karratha are abolished.

6. Consequential directions

- (1) In order to give effect to clauses 4(2) and 5 —
 - (a) Part 4 of the Act applies to preparing for and conducting any ordinary election for which next election day is the ordinary election day as if the changes effected by clauses 4(2) and 5 take effect on commencement day; and
 - (b) the operation of Part 4 of the Act is modified to the extent necessary for the purposes of paragraph (a).

Local Government (Karratha) Change Order 2023

- (2) In order to give effect to clause 4(3) —
- (a) Part 4 of the Act applies to preparing for and conducting any ordinary election for which subsequent election day is the ordinary election day as if the changes effected by clause 4(3) take effect on 1 July 2025; and

 - (ii) the remainder will retire in 2027;and
 - (b) the operation of the Act is modified to the extent necessary for the purposes of paragraph (a).
