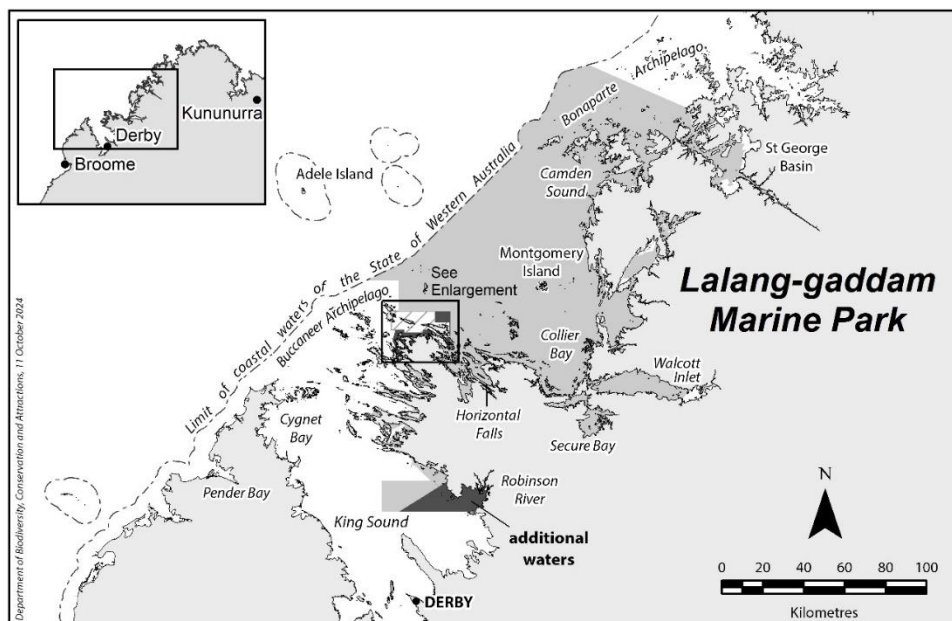

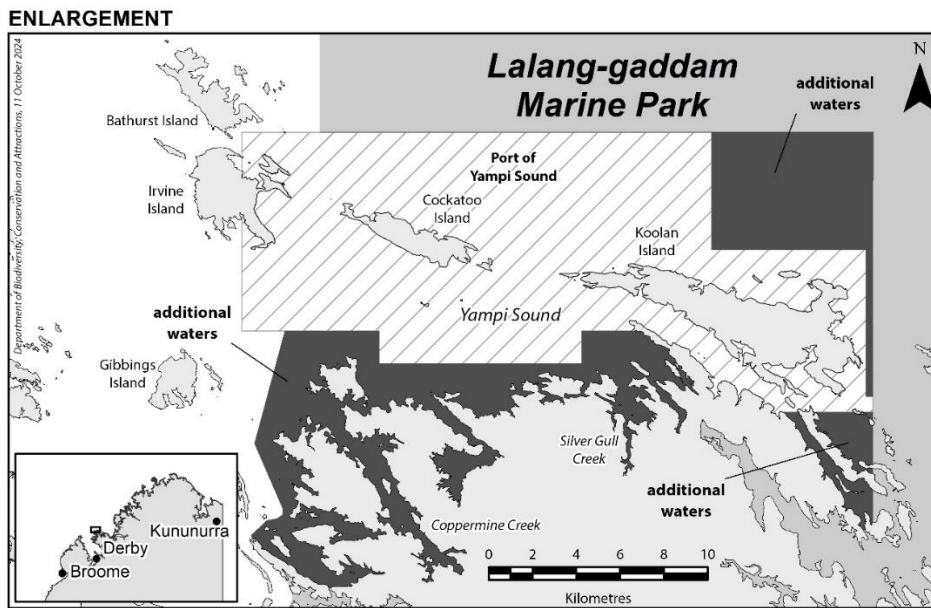

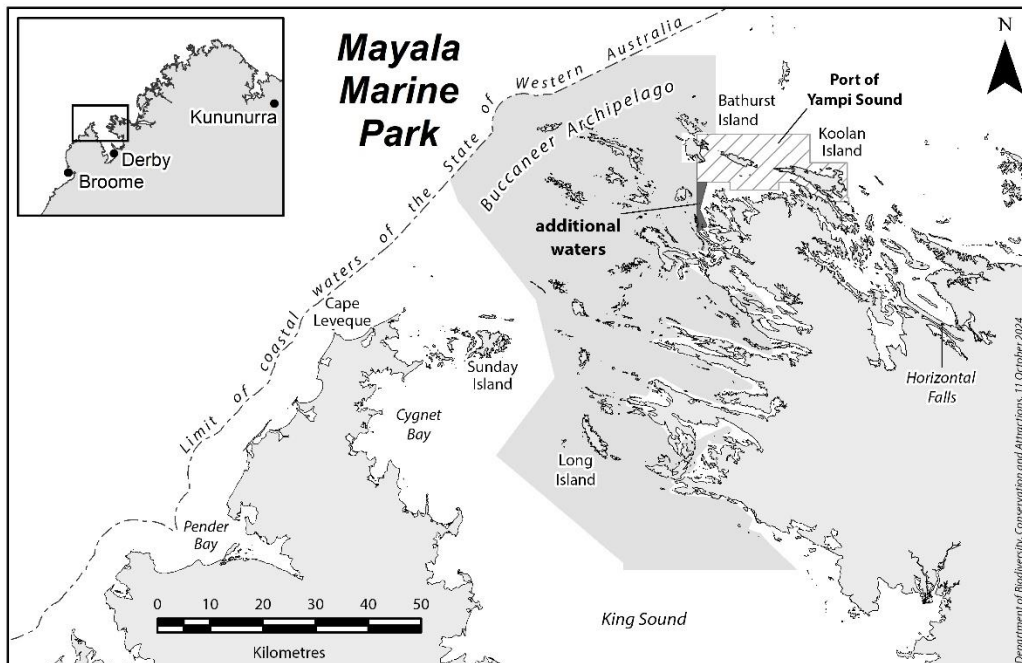

*City of Bayswater***KEEPING AND CONTROL OF CATS AMENDMENT LOCAL LAW 2024**

Under the powers conferred by the *Cat Act 2011*, the *Local Government Act 1995* and under all other powers enabling it, the Council of the City of Bayswater resolved on 22 October 2024 to make the following amendment local law.

**PART 1—PRELIMINARY****1. Citation**

This local law may be cited as the *City of Bayswater Keeping and Control of Cats Amendment Local Law 2024*.

**2. Commencement**

This local law comes into operation 14 days after the date of its publication in the *Government Gazette*.



### 3. Principal Local Law

This local law amends the *City of Bayswater Keeping and Control of Cats Local Law 2022* published in the *Government Gazette* on 7 October 2022 as amended by the *City of Bayswater Keeping and Control of Cats Amendment Local Law 2023* published in the *Government Gazette* on 1 September 2023 (“Principal Local Law”).

### 4. Clause 2.3 inserted

Clause 3.2 “Cats in other places” of the *Shire of Northam’s Cat Local Law 2019* gazetted on 29 October 2019 is adopted and inserted as clause 2.3 in the Principal Local Law with the following modifications—

- (a) in subclause (2) “3.2(1)” is deleted and “2.3(1)” inserted;
- (b) in subclause (4) “Shire of Northam Cat Local Law 2019” is deleted and “this local law” inserted;
- (c) the term “Authorised Person” wherever it appears is deleted and “authorised person” inserted in its place; and
- (d) the term “keeper” wherever it appears is deleted and “owner” inserted in its place.
