1. Citation

This notice may be cited as the *Electoral (Political Finance) Notice 2025*.

2. Definition

In this notice a reference to “**regulation**” is a reference to a regulation in the *Electoral (Political Finance) Regulations 1996*.

3. Application

This notice applies—

- (a) To the first periodic elections for the Legislative Assembly and the Legislative Council, respectively, held after this notice is published; and
- (b) To any subsequent periodic election or other election,

And applies to third-party campaigners generally.

4. Modified operation of *Electoral (Political Finance) Regulations 1996*

(1) Computerised accounting systems may be used to keep the following records required under regulations 23 to 24—

- (a) A receipt book; and
- (b) An acknowledgement book

(2) Where computerised accounting systems are used as authorised by subclause (1), regulations 23 to 24 operate as if they were repealed and the following regulations were inserted instead—

23. Receipt book for money

(1A) This regulation applies to money received by a third-party campaigner.

(1) If the receipt book is kept using a computerised accounting system, the following information must be recorded and printed—

- (a) The date of the receipt;
- (b) The amount of money received by the third-party campaigner;
- (c) The form (*for example: cash, cheque, electronic transfer, postal order etc.*) in which the money was received;
- (d) The name and address of the person, body or organisation by whom or which or on whose behalf the amount is paid; and
- (e) The purpose of the payment.

(2) When—

- (a) a gift of money; or
- (b) an amount of money, being the proceeds of the sale of a gift made to the third-party campaigner, is received by the third party campaigner, the agent of the third-party campaigner must record, or cause to be recorded, the particulars referred to in subregulation (1) for the amount received

(3) An entry under subregulation (2)(b) has to contain a cross-reference to the entry in the acknowledgment book that relates to the gift in question.

24. Acknowledgement book for gift (other than money) or services

(1A) This regulation applies to a gift (other than money), including an interest in property, received by a third-party campaigner.

(1) If the Acknowledgement book is kept using a computerised accounting system, the following information must be recorded and printed—

- (a) the date of the acknowledgement; and
- (b) sequential number of the acknowledgement
- (c) the value of any gift made to the third-party campaigner; and
- (d) a description of the gift; and
- (e) the name and address of the person, body or organisation by whom or which or on whose behalf the gift is made; and
- (f) the purpose for which the gift is made.

(2) When a gift is received by the third-party campaigner, the agent of the third-party campaigner must record, or cause to be recorded, the particulars referred to in subregulation (1).
