- (f) consequential works in the Collie region related to reconfiguration of the current Muja terminal to Northern terminal transmission lines, and Palmer terminal to Shotts terminal transmission lines, into transmission lines from Muja terminal to Shotts terminal, and Shotts terminal to Northern terminal; and
