HIS Excellency the Governor in Executive Council has been pleased to approve of the following Regulations, made under the provisions of "The Early Closing Act, 1902," and its amendments.

Regulations under "The Early Closing Act, 1902" (1 & 2 Edwd. VII.,
No. 24, as amended by Acts No. 1 and No. 52 of 1904).

In pursuance of the powers and authorities conferred by "The Early Closing Act, 1902," and its amendments, and of every other power and authority enabling him in that behalf, His Excellency the Governor of Western Australia, by and with the advice of the Executive Council thereof, doth repeal all existing Regulations under the said Acts and make the following Regulations, that is to say:—

1. In the following regulations and forms the term "the Act" shall mean "The Early Closing Act, 1902," as amended by "The Early Closing Amendment Act, 1904," and "The Early Closing Amendment Act, 1904" (No. 2).
