WHEREAS by "The Constitution Act, 1889," it is provided that the Governor may, whenever he may think fit, by Proclamation or otherwise, prorogue the Parliament: Now THEREFORE I, the said Governor, in exercise of the powers conferred by "The Constitution Act, 1889," do by this Proclamation prorogue the Parliament as from the fifth day of October instant until the seventh day of November next.

Given under my hand and the Public Seal of the said State, at Perth, this ninth day of October, 1905.
