THE BONDS ACT, 1911.

Melville Road Board.

NOTICE is hereby given that the Melville Road Board proposes, pursuant to an order, approved of by His Excellency the Governor in Council (publishing in the Government Gazette of 1th November, 1913, page 2681), under the provisions of "The Bonds Act, 1911," to borrow the sum of Two thousand pounds (£2,000), the said sum to be repaid by the sale of debentures bearing interest at 4½ per centum per annum.

The purpose for which such loan is to be applied is the purchase of electricity in such sections of jobs, mains and manholes, and the supply of current to streets and private premises.

It is proposed to expend the moneys so raised for the purpose aforesaid, within each of the boundaries of the Melville Ward, as are more particularly set out in the plans and specifications herewith mentioned.

Interest on the said debentures is to be payable half-yearly at the Commonwealth Bank of Australia, St. George's Terrace, Perth, and the principal moneys due thereunder are to be paid at the Commonwealth Bank of Australia, St. George's Terrace, Perth, ten years after the date of issue of the said debentures.

The plans and specifications and an estimate of the cost, and a statement showing the proposed application of the said sum of £2,000 on the proposed works are open for inspection for one month after the publication thereof at the office of the Melville Road Board, Cantoning Road, Hilton, on Mondays to Fridays, between the hours of 9 a.m. and 12 noon and 2 p.m. and 5 p.m., and Saturdays from 10 a.m. to 12 noon.

Two pounds per centum on the amount of the said loan will be levied every year in accordance with the provisions of "The Bonds Act, 1911," in form a stub-book filed.
