WHEREAS it is enacted by "The Factories and Shops Act, 1920," that the expression "Public Holiday" shall mean certain days therein specified and any other day declared by Proclamation to be a public holiday for the purposes of the said Act: Now therefore I, the said Governor, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, acting under the powers contained in the said Act and every other power me in this behalf enabling, do hereby proclaim and declare that Monday, the 2nd day of May, 1921, shall be a public holiday throughout the State, for the purposes of the said Act, and shall be observed as a public holiday under every part of the said Act in which the expression occurs.
