WHEREAS by "The Constitution Act, 1889," it is provided that it shall be lawful for the Governor to prorogue the Legislative Council and the Legislative Assembly from time to time, by Proclamation, whenever

he shall think fit: Now, therefore I, the said Governor, in exercise of the power conferred by the said Act, do hereby prorogue the Legislative Council and the Legislative Assembly until the 2nd day of August, 1928.
