

## IN THE COURT OF ARBITRATION OF WESTERN AUSTRALIA.

No. 1 of 1932.

In the matter of an Industrial Dispute between Andrew Douglas and the Master Builders and Contractors' Association of Western Australia Union of Employers, of the one part, and John Bridgman, Edward Bower, James Fowler, Charles Green, and other members of the Operative Stonemasons' Union of Workers, of the other part.

WHEREAS an industrial dispute arose between the abovenamed parties; and whereas I, as President of the Court of Arbitration, acting herein in pursuance of the powers conferred by Section 145 of "The Industrial Arbitration Act, 1912-1925," convened a conference of the representatives of the parties concerned in the said dispute; and whereas the said conference took place at the Arbitration Court, Perth, on the 29th day of January and 2nd day of February, 1932; and whereas an agreement has been reached as to the whole of the matters in dispute: Now, therefore I, as President of the said Court of Arbitration, in pursuance of the powers and directions contained in the said Section 145 and in Section 63 of the said Act, do sign the memorandum hereunto annexed as embodying the matters upon which an agreement has been reached, and the terms and conditions agreed upon, which memorandum (hereinafter called "Agreement") I do forward to the Clerk of the Court and direct that the same shall be filed by him in pursuance of Section 145 and Section 63 of the said Act.

## (1) Area:

This Agreement shall have effect over the area comprised within a radius of 20 miles from the General Post Office, Perth.

## (2) Term:

The term of this Agreement shall be twelve months from the 2nd February, 1932.

## (3) Wages:

Basic wage—£3 13s. 6d. per week.

The wages of an operative or journeyman stonemason shall be 2/5-8/11d. per hour, which rate is made up by the following amounts in addition to the basic wage:—Margin, £1 4s. 0d.; Holidays, 5s. 0d.; Lost time, 6s. 0d.; Tool allowance, 6d.

## (4) General:

All other terms and conditions obtaining in the industry prior to the occurrence of the industrial dispute shall continue in full force and effect.
