1. This Order may be cited as Prices Control Order No. 356.

2. Prices Control Order No. 51, as amended by Prices Control Orders Nos. 55 and 212 is hereby further amended by deleting from paragraph 4 thereof as amended, subparagraph (b) (ii) reading:—

(ii) An amount equal to forty-two and one-half per centum of (i),

and inserting in its stead the following:—

(ii) An amount equal to 40 per centum of (i).
