### HEALTH ACT, 1911-1960.

Shire of Melville.

P.H.D. 797/61.

WHEREAS under the provisions of the Health Act, 1911-1960, a local health authority may make or adopt by-laws and may alter, amend or repeal any by-laws so made or adopted: Now, therefore, the Shire of Melville, being a local authority within the meaning of the Act and having adopted the Model By-Laws described as Series "A" and reprinted, pursuant to the Reprinting of Regulations Act, 1954, in the *Government Gazette*, of the 9th August, 1956, with modifications, and having further amended the said adopted by-laws as set out by notice published in the *Government Gazette* on 25th July, 1958, and 12th December, 1958, doth hereby resolve that the said adopted by-laws shall be amended as follows:—

After by-law 28 (b) add the following:—

Notwithstanding by-law 28 (a) where a person obtains a certificate from the Medical Officer of Health that it is necessary for that person to have supplies of goats milk the Council may grant a license to that person to keep one milking goat on his premises, as long as a supply of goats milk is not readily available from other sources; subject to the following conditions:—

- (i) That the license will remain in force only as long as the supply of goats milk is necessary for medical purposes, and the person continues to reside at the premises.
- (ii) That reasonable facilities are provided on the premises for the keeping of one milking goat.
- (iii) That no nuisance is caused by the keeping of such milking goat.
- (iv) That the Council may cancel such license at any time.
