## HEALTH ACT, 1911-1968.

## Shire of Mukinbudin.

WHEREAS it is provided in the Health Act, 1911-1968, as amended, that a local authority may, of its own motion, by resolution, adopt with or without modification the whole or any portion of by-laws caused to be prepared by the Governor under the provisions of Section 343 (1) of that Act; and whereas Model By-laws, described as Series "A", prepared in accordance with those provisions and duly amended have pursuant to the Reprinting of Regulations Act, 1954, been reprinted with amendments to and including that published in the *Government Gazette* on 25th June, 1963, and as so reprinted have been published in the *Government Gazette* on 17th July, 1963; and further amended *inter alia* by notices published in the *Government Gazette* on 20th March, 1964; 8th January, 1965; 14th April, 1966; 12th October, 1967; 30th July, 1968; 28th November, 1968; 17th December, 1968 and 7th March, 1969: Now, therefore, the Shire of Mukinbudin, being a local authority within the meaning of the said Act, doth hereby resolve and determine that the said Model By-laws, as so reprinted and published in the *Government Gazette* on the 17th July, 1963, together with the amendments published in the *Government Gazette* on 20th March, 1964; 8th January, 1965; 14th April, 1966; 12th October, 1967; 30th July, 1968; 28th November, 1968; 17th December, 1968 and 7th March, 1969, shall be adopted without modification and doth hereby also prescribe the following scale of fees as applied to Schedule "D" of Part IX of the adopted by-laws:—

## PART IX.—OFFENSIVE TRADES.
