### PROCLAMATION

WESTERN AUSTRALIA, } By His Excellency Major-General Sir Douglas  
TO WIT, } Anthony Kendrew, Knight Commander of the

Governor. } Saint George, Companion of the Most Honour-

Companion of the Distinguished Service Order,  
Governor in and over the State of Western  
Australia and its Dependencies in the Com-  
monwealth of Australia.

WHEREAS it is enacted by section 2 of the District Court of Western Australia Act Amendment Act, 1970 that—

- (a) the Act, except paragraph (b) of section 3, shall come into operation on the date the Act receives the Royal Assent; and
- (b) paragraph (b) of section 3 of the Act shall come into operation on a date to be fixed by proclamation:

Now, therefore, I, the Governor, acting with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, do hereby fix the day on which this proclamation is published in the *Government Gazette* as the day on which paragraph (b) of section 3 of the District Court of Western Australia Act Amendment Act, 1970, shall come into operation.

### PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS it is enacted, *inter alia*, by subsections (2) and (3) of section 172 of the Companies Act, 1961-1969, that the Governor may, by proclamation, declare that a company is a company to which Division 4 of Part VI of the Act applies and that a declaration shall not be made in respect of a company unless the Governor is satisfied that it is in the public interest that allegations of fraud, misfeasance or other misconduct by persons who are or have been concerned with the formation or management of the company should be investigated under that Division: Now, therefore, I, the Governor, acting with the advice and consent of the Executive Council and in exercise of the powers conferred by section 172 of the Companies Act, 1961-1969, being satisfied that it is in the public interest that allegations of fraud, misfeasance or other misconduct of persons who are or have been concerned with the formation or management of Barewa Oil & Mining N.L. should be investigated under Division 4 of Part VI of that Act, do Hereby Declare that that company is a company to which that Division applies.
