WHEREAS by section 31 (1) (a) of the Land Act 1933, the Governor may by Proclamation and subject to such conditions as may be expressed therein classify as of Class "A" any such lands of the Crown reserved to Her Majesty for any purpose and whereas it is deemed expedient that Reserve No. 38924 (Avon Location 28805) for the purpose of "Conservation of Flora and Fauna" as described hereunder, should be classified as of Class "A": Now, therefore I, the Governor, with the advice and consent of Executive Council do by this my Proclamation classify as of Class "A" the reserve described hereunder.

Reserve No. 38924 comprising Avon Location 28805 containing an area of 930.690 3 hectares.

(Plan Toodyay 1:25 000 S.W. and Swan 10 000 8.3 and 8.4.)
