CONSUMER AFFAIRS ACT 1972

INTERIM ORDER

I, Allen Henry Tenger, Acting Commissioner for Consumer Affairs, noting that goods identical or similar to goods known as the Laser Gun and being the subject of an Order under Section 23R (1) of the *Consumer Affairs Act 1972* gazetted in the *Government Gazette* 2 April 1993 have been available for supply, and acting pursuant to section 23Q (1), prohibit the supply of the class of goods described in the Schedule for a period not exceeding 28 days from the date on which this Order is published in the *Government Gazette*. Dated this 23rd day of December 1993.

Goods intended for use as a toy or toy and key ring, operating on two batteries, featuring different sounds when trigger is activated and known by the names of the Laser Gun, Laser Pistol Key Chain, Hot Shot Pocket Laser Gun, Shark Gun, X7 Cyber Blaster, X20 Cyber Blaster or any other name.
