ASCOT KILNS PRECINCT REDEVELOPMENT**

Call for Public Submissions

The Western Australian Planning Commission (WAPC) intends to amend the Metropolitan Region Scheme (MRS) for land in the local government of Belmont and is seeking public comment.

The amendment proposes to transfer land between the parks and recreation reservation to the urban zone in the MRS.

The Western Australian Planning Commission certifies that, in its opinion, the proposed amendment does not constitute a substantial alteration to the MRS.
