



Sandalwood Act 1929

Sandalwood (Limitation of Removal of Sandalwood) Order 2015

Made by the Governor in Executive Council under section 2 of the *Sandalwood Act 1929*.

1. Citation

This order may be cited as the *Sandalwood (Limitation of Removal of Sandalwood) Order 2015*.

2. Limitation

- (1) The quantity of wild sandalwood that may be pulled or removed from Crown land and alienated land during each period to which this sub-clause applies is limited to a total of 2,500 tonnes, comprising —
 - (a) a maximum of 1,250 tonnes of green sandalwood; and
 - (b) a minimum of 1,250 tonnes of dead sandalwood.
- (2) The quantity of sandalwood includes all parts of the tree except leaves, bark and small branches (less than 25 millimetres diameter at the large end under bark).
- (3) Subclauses (1) and (2) apply to the period commencing on 1 July 2016 and ending on 30 June 2026.

3. 1996 order repealed

The *Sandalwood (Limitation of Removal of Sandalwood) Order 1996** is repealed on 30 June 2016.
