THE Governor directs it to be notified, for general information, that the undermentioned Acts have passed the Legislative Council, viz. :—

1.—An Act to amend an Act intituled “An Act for establishing a Court of Civil Judicature.”

2.—An Act for the Recovery of small Debts in Districts remote from Perth.

3.—An Act for attaching Debts, Goods, Monies, and Effects, in the hands of third Parties.

4.—An Act for adopting and applying certain Acts of Parliament passed in the first, second and third, and the Fourth years of the Reign of His present Majesty, respectively, in the Administra-

tion of Justice in the Colony of Western Australia in like manner as other Laws of England are applied therein.
