## PROCLAMATION.

By His Excellency Sir JAMES STIRLING, Knt., Governor and Commander-in-Chief of the Colony of Western Australia and its Dependencies, and Vice-Admiral of the same.

"HEREAS, by the third Section of the Act of Council, passed in the second year of the reign of William the Fourth, No. 4, intituled "An Act to extend the Jurisdiction and regulate the Proceedings of the Court of Quarter Sessions," it is enacted, "that the Sessions of the said Court shall be held at such times and places as the Governor shall from time to time appoint by Proclamation;" and whereas the holding of the said Court at Fremantle, as heretofore, has been found to be inconvenient and expensive to the public, and a suitable Edifice for the Sessions of the said Court has been lately erected at Perth: -Now, THEREFORE, I, the Governor, do hereby, by this my Proclamation, pursuant to the provisions of the said Enactment, appoint the Town of Perth for the holding of the Sessions of the said Court, instead of Fremantle, as heretofore.
