PECER BROWN

A Bill to extend the Jurisdiction of Magistrates in cases of dispute between Masters and Servants

Preamble Whereas it is expedient to empower the Mugis rates of the Colony to hear and determine all cases of complaint by or against Master- and Servan s of every description, whather domestic servants, servanis in busbandry, or any other sort of servants; or by or against Artificers, Workanen, and Laborers, employed to perform any work, whether by the four or the day, or in any other manner in espect of time, or by the piece or the job, or in any other manner in respect of work;

It is proposed that the several enactments and provisions of the English Law relative to disputes between Musters and Servanes so far as the same are applicable to the circumstances of this Colony, shall be deemed and taken to apply to Servants of every description, as well domestic servants as other wise, whatever may be be nature or the term of the service; and to Artificers, Workmen, and Laborers of every description employed to perform any work, whatever may be the nature or the mode of such employ ment.
