THE Governor having had under his consideration the inexpediency and im- policy of allowing the Colonial schooner to be employed as a carrying vessel for private goods between the outports, whereby individual enterprise is very much interfered with, and attempts to establish colonial coast- ing vessels completely prevented,—and, as

it is evident that so long as this system continues no efforts will be made by the settlers themselves to establish any communication between the stations on the coast,—His Ex- cellency directs it to be notified for public information, that from and after the 1st of April, 1841, no private goods will be per- mitted to be taken on board the Colonial schooner except in cases of the most absolute and urgent necessity.
