WESTERN AUSTRALIA. VICTORIZEREGINZE.

By Hiz Excellency John Hutt, Esq., Governor and Commander-in-Chief in and over the Territory of Western Aus-tralia, and its Dependencies, and Vice-Admiral of the same, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof thereof.

No. III.

An Act for applying certain sums arising from the Revenue receivable in the Colony of Western Australia to the service thereof, for the Financial Year commencing First of April, One thousand eight hundred and forty-five.

Whereas power and authority have been vested in the Governor of Western Aus-

tralia, acting with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council of the said Colony, to make, ordain, and establish all such Laws and Ordinances as may be necessary for the maintenance of the peace, order, and good government of the same-Be it therefore enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Western Australia, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof, that out of the produce of the Revenue of the said Colony there shall and may be issued and applied any sum or sums not exceeding Seven thousand Five hundred and Twenty-six pounds, Twelve shillings, and Six pence, for defraying the expenses of those establishments chargeable on the Colonial Fund for the year commencing first of April, one thousand eight hundred and forty-five, as hereinafter more particularly expressed—that is to say,

And be it enseted, that the said Treasurer shall in his accounts from time to time be allowed credit for any sum or sums of money paid by him in pursuance of such warrant or order in writing as aforesaid, and that the receipt or receipts of the respective persons to whom the same shall be so paid shall be a full and valid discharge to the said Treasurer in passing his said accounts, for any such sum or sums of money as shall be therein mentioned, and that he shall and do receive credit for the same accordingly.
