By His Excellency JOHN HUTT, Es-quire, Governor and Commander-in-Chief of the Territory of Wes-tern Australia and its Depen-dencies, and Vice-Admiral of the same.

In pursuance of the authority in me vested by a certain Act of the Imperial Parliament of Great Britain and Ireland, and passed in the fourth and fifth years of Majesty's reign, intituled "An Act Her " for regulating the Sale of Waste Lands " belonging to the Crown in the Australian
