Numerous applications having been made for the situation of Jetty keeper of the Perth Town Trust Jetty, which is to become vacant from the last day of this month, His Excellency deems it most conducive to the benefit of the Revenue to throw the place open to PUBLIC COMPETITION; with this view therefore TENDERS will be received at this office on MONDAY, THE 30TH., at 11 o'clock, for farming the Toll Dues and Charges to be collected at the said Jetty, for the space of twelve calendar months from the 1st of December next.

These DUES produced last year, about the sum of £60.

The TOLL-HOUSE and ROADWAY of the Jetty, are to be kept in repair by the Tenant, and the Tenders should contain the names of satisfactory Sureties who will be responsible for the Rent and Repairs.

The Rent is to be paid half-yearly.
