Proclamation.

By His Excellency Lieut.-Col. FREDERICK CHIDLEY IRWIN, Knight Companion of the Royal Hanoverian Guelphic Order, Governor and Commander-in-Chief of the Territory of Western Australia and its Dependencies and Vice-Admiral of the same.

In pursuance of the authority in me vested, by a certain Act of the Imperial Parliament of Great Britain and Ireland, and passed in the 5th & 6th years of Her Majesty's Reign, intituled "An Act for regulating the sale of Waste Lands belonging to the Crown in the Australian Colonies," I do hereby notify and proclaim, that the following portion of land in the Avon district will be offered for sale by Public Auction by the Collector of Revenue at Perth on Wednesday, the 5th day of July 1848, at the upset price affixed thereto, on the terms and conditions set forth in certain land regulations, dated 14th June 1848.

Avon Location No. 59, comprising 160 acres more or less extending 53 chains 33 links NNW and 30 chains WSW from North corner of Avon location No. 20.

Upset price £1 per acre.
