Regulations for Tenders.

HIS Excellency the Governor directs it to be notified for general information, that in future, full Plans and Specifications for the performance of any Government works will be deposited in the Office of the Colonial Secretary for inspection, two clear days before the date notified for the receipt of the Tenders, and reference for further particulars must be made to the Superintendent of Public Works.

Parties tendering will be required to give a guarantee for the completion of the work within a given time.

Where the work specified is of Masonry and of House-carpentry, or of either apart, separate amounts must be inserted in the Tender.

If the whole work is tendered for, that of building and plastering must form an item; and that of carpentry and joining, and, as the case may be, of painting and glazing, another.

All Tenders to be sent in to the Colonial Secretary's Office *sealed*, and the nature of the work tendered for to be written on the cover.
