**Proclamation.**

*By His Excellency* CHARLES FITZGERALD  
ESQUIRE, *Commander of the Royal Navy,  
Governor and Commander-in-Chief in  
and over the Territory of Western Aus-  
tralia and its Dependencies, and Vice  
Admiral of the same.*

In pursuance of the authority in me vested by a certain Ordinance of the Legislative Council, No. XX of the 4th Victoria, intituled "An Ordinance to establish a Toll to be levied on Sandal-wood, to be applied to the construction and repair of public roads and lines of communication," and which provides (section 8th) "that it shall be lawful for the Governor with the advice of the Executive Council at any time by Proclamation under his hand to suspend the operation of this Ordinance for such time as he may deem expedient." I do hereby notify and proclaim the suspension of the operation of the aforesaid Ordinance, until the first day of January, 1849, in order that time may be allowed for ascertaining the state of the Sandal-wood market in China and elsewhere.
