**W**HEREAS an Ordinance was passed by the Legislative Council of this Colony in the 14th year of the Reign of Her present Majesty, (No. 14.) intituled, "An Ordinance for the Licensing of Carts and Carriers" by the first section of which it is enacted that the provisions of the same shall be extended to such townsites as the Governor from time to time shall appoint: Now, therefore, I the Governor, in virtue of the power so vested in me, do hereby extend the provisions of the said recited Ordinance to the Town of Bunbury.

**T**ENDERS (in duplicate) will be received at this Office up to 12 o'clock on WEDNESDAY, the 7th day of May, next, for furnishing the undermentioned PILES and SCANTLINGS, deliverable at the Whaling Jetty at Fremantle, viz.:

No. 10 Main Piles, 12x9 and 20 feet long.

" 8 Spur Piles, 9 x 9 and 12 feet long. To be squared and perfectly straight, and one end pointed.

" 180 Sheet Planking, 9x3½, 12 feet long, sawn, and one end pointed.

" 20 Pieces of Scantling, 6 inches deep, cut bevel, 3 inches top and 4½ bottom, and 16 feet long.

" 26 Pieces 8x4, 9 feet long.

" 16 Pieces 8x4, 10 feet long.

The whole of the above to be of the best description of Mahogany, straight grained, and subject to the examination and approval of the Superintendent of Public Works.

One-third of the above quantity (in equal proportions) is to be delivered within 14 days from the date of contract, and the remainder within one month from the same period.
