**Proclamation.**

*By His Excellency CHARLES FITZGERALD, Esquire, Commander in the Royal Navy, Governor and Commander-in-Chief, in and over the Territory of Western Australia and its Dependencies and Vice-Admiral of the same.*

IN pursuance of the authority in me vested by a certain Act of the Imperial Parliament of Great Britain and Ireland, passed in the 5th and 6th years of Her Majesty's reign, intituled, "An Act for regulating the sale of Waste Lands belonging to the crown in the Australian colonies." I do hereby notify and proclaim that the following portions of land will be offered for Sale by Public Auction, by the Collector or Sub-Collectors of Revenue, at the places and on the days hereinafter mentioned, at one o'clock, at the upset price affixed to each lot respectively, on the terms and conditions set forth in certain Land Regulations dated 14th June, 1843.

*At Perth, on Wednesday, the 2nd July next—*

Swan Location No. 126, comprising 15 acres more or less, in the form of a square, extending  $12\frac{1}{4}$  chains east, and  $12\frac{1}{4}$  chains north from the S.E. corner of Mr Brockman's Swan Location, No. 101. Upset price £1 per acre.

Perth Building Lot, N. 4. Upset price £12.

Perth Suburban Allotment, No. 48, containing 3a. 1r. 20p. Upset Price £4 per acre.

HIS Excellency the Governor has been pleased to direct the publication of the following order, in pursuance of the

Act of Council, 3 & 4 William 4, No. 2, intituled "an Act for the Regulation of Weights and Measures":—

It is hereby ordered, that the following places and persons be appointed, and they are hereby appointed, in which and with whom respectively, the Standard Weights and Measures shall be deposited: and it is notified, that the persons so appointed to be Keepers of Standard Weights and Measures will produce the same to any person or persons demanding an inspection thereof, at any reasonable hour or time, for the purpose of comparing the same with any other weights and measures. And such keepers are entitled to charge a fee of Sixpence for each and every weight and measure so compared. And it is further ordered that the Weights and Measures which shall be authenticated and delivered by the Inspector of each district to such Keeper, shall, for the present be considered the standard Weights and Measures for such district.
