Proclamation.

By His Excellency CHARLES FITZGERALD,
*Esquire, Commander in the Royal Navy,
Governor and Commander-in-Chief, in
and over the Territory of Western Aus-
tralia and its Dependencies and Vice-Ad-
miral of the same.*

IN pursuance of the authority in me
vested by a certain Act of the Impe-
rial Parliament of Great Britain and Ire-
land, passed in the 5th and 6th years of
Her Majesty's reign, intituled, "An Act
for regulating the sale of Waste Lands be-
longing to the crown in the Australian colo-
nies." I do hereby notify and proclaim that
the following portions of land will be offered
for Sale by Public Auction, by the Col-
lector and Sub-Collectors of Revenue, at
the places and on the days hereinafter
mentioned, at one o'clock, at the upset
price affixed to each lot respectively, on the
terms and conditions set forth in certain
Land Regulations dated 14th June, 1843.

*By the Collector of Revenue, at Perth,
on Wednesday, the 3rd September next,—*

Swan Location No. 129.—Comprising 16 acres
more or less, in form of an average square with
frontage on the shore of Melville Water, the
West boundary extending North from the same
through the stem of a marked flooded gum tree,
nearly a quarter of a mile below Gallop's Location.
