Proclamation.

By His Excellency CHARLES FITZGERALD, Esquire, Commander in the Royal Navy, Governor and Commander-in-Chief, in and over the Territory of Western Australia and its Dependencies and Vice-Admiral of the same.

IN pursuance and in exercise of the power and authority for that purpose in me vested by a certain Ordinance, passed in the 14th year of the reign of her present Majesty, intituled "An Ordinance to provide for the due custody and discipline of Offenders Transported to Western Australia, and of Offenders sentenced therein to Transportation." I do hereby with the advice and consent of my Executive Council, by this my Proclamation published in the *Government Gazette*, appoint all that piece or parcel of land situate in the Town of Fremantle, in the said colony, comprising and described in the maps and plans of the Surveyor General's Office as Fremantle Building Lots 150, 151, 152, 175, 176, 177, 178, and certain other Crown land contiguous thereto, together with all buildings and appurtenances thereto belonging, all which said land, buildings, and premises have heretofore been and now are used, occupied, and commonly known as the Convict Establishment, to be a place of confinement for the reception and detention at hard labour of Convicts, now being or hereafter to be in the said colony under sentence, passed in the said colony or elsewhere, of Transportation.

Given under my hand and the Public Seal of the Colony at Perth, this 6th day of October, 1851.
