Proclamation.

By His Excellency CHARLES FITZGERALD,
Esquire, Commander in the Royal Navy,
Governor and Commander-in-Chief, in
and over the Territory of Western Aus-
tralia and its Dependencies and Vice-Ad-
miral of the same.

IN pursuance of the authority in me ves-
ted by a certain Act of the Imperial
Parliament, passed in the 5th and 6th
years of Her Majesty's reign, intituled
"An Act for regulating the sale of Waste
Lands belonging to the crown in the Aus-
tralian Colonies," I do hereby notify and
proclaim that the following portions of
land will be offered for Sale by Public
Auction, by the Collector and Sub-Collec-
tors of Revenue, at the places and on the
days hereinafter mentioned, at one o'clock
at the upset price affixed to each lot re-
spectively, on the terms and conditions set
forth in certain Land Regulations, dated
14th June, 1843:—

At Fremantle, on Thursday, the 6th
May next,—

Fremantle Building Lot No. 562. Upset price
£30.

At Bunbury, on Wednesday, the 12th
May next,—

Wellington Location No. 76—Comprising 60
acres more or less, extending 24 chains West, and
25 chains South from a spot 19 chains West from
S.E. corner of Wellington Location No. 45, op-
posite boundaries parallel and equal, and all bear-
ings and boundaries true; upset price £1 per acre.
