PROCLAMATION.

By His Excellency Arthur Edward Kennedy, Esquire, Governor and Commander-in-Chief, in and over the Territory of Western Australia and its Dependencies, and Vice Admiral of the same.

WHEREAS by an Ordinance of the Legislative Council of the said Colony, passed in the Twentyfourth Year of the Reign of Her Most Gracious Majesty No. 15 of 1861, it is, amongst other things enacted That such Ordinance should come into operation and be in force immediately from and after the publication thereof by Proclamation in the Government Gazette : Now know all Men that by Virtue and in exercise of the Authority in me vested, I do hereby notify and proclaim that the said Ordinance shall be, and the same is hereby published accordingly.

Given under my hand and the Public Seal at Perth this 17th day of June, One Thousand Eight Hundred and Sixty One.
