GOVERNOR KENNEDY on relinquishing the Government of Western Australia, desires to thank The Officer Commanding the Troops, the heads of Departments, Magistrates, and public Officers, for the valuable aid and support they have afforded him, during his administration.

The Governor is deeply sensible of the obligation he owes to The Lord Bishop of Perth, and the Clergy of all denominations, for the practical interest they have taken in the moral and spiritual welfare of the people among whom they have so earnestly laboured. His Excellency feels confident that one and all will continue to pursue the path of public duty, in the manner which has redounded so much to the welfare of the community, and their own honor.
