WELLINGTON RESIDENCY.—

Bounded on the *West* by the sea-coast; on the *North* by an East line from the said coast to the River Murray passing through the summit of Mount William, then the Murray and Williams Rivers upwards (exclusive of the licenses and locations on either bank of each) to Bannister townsite on the Williams, and then an East line indefinitely: and on the *South* by an East line from the seacoast to Capel River through the North end of Wonnerop Inlet, then by said river upwards to location 171 (inclusive), then by a South-easterly line to junction of Padbury Brook with the River Blackwood, then by the Blackwood upwards to its junction with Balgarrup River, and then by an East line indefinitely. All bearings true
