PROCLAMATION.

By His Excellency John Stephen Hampton, Esquire, Governor and Commander-in-Chief in and over the Territory of Western Australia and its Dependencies, and Vice Admiral of the same,

WHEREAS the undermentioned Ordinances were passed by me the said Governor, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council of the said Colony in the 25th year of the reign of Her Majesty, Nos 2, 16, 17, and 19, and respectively entitled—

“An Ordinance for Vesting the Ordnance Lands and Buildings in the Principal Secretary of State for the War Department.”

“An Ordinance to confirm the Expenditure for the Services of the year 1861 beyond the grant for that year.”

“An Ordinance to appropriate and apply the sum of Sixty Seven Thousand, Eight Hundred and Three Pounds out of the General Revenue of the Colony for the Service of the year 1863.”

An Ordinance to amend “An Ordinance for Vesting the Ordnance Lands and Buildings in the Principal Secretary of State for the War Department”

Now therefore I the said Governor do hereby proclaim and make known unto all whom it may concern that Her Majesty has been graciously pleased to confirm and allow the same.

Given under my hand and the public seal of the Colony, at Government House, Perth, this 13th day of December, 1862.

THE Board appointed by His Excellency the Governor for the purpose of Licensing Boats and Boatmen for the year 1863, will assemble at the Court House, Fremantle, on Wednesday, the 31st December inst., at 10 o'clock in the forenoon, also on Thursday, the 14th January, 1863, at the same hour.

Owners of Boats and Flats in Perth and Fremantle will have their Boats ready for inspection at the North or South Jetties between the hours of ten and twelve on the respective Licensing days.

Names and Numbers to be painted upon Boats before submitted to the inspection of the Board.

Boatmen applying for Licenses under the Act, will come prepared with such Certificates of Character and competency as they may be able to obtain.

All persons found working Boats without a License after the above-mentioned Licensing Days, will be fined according to Act of Council.

Cart Licenses will also be granted on the same days.
