For each horned head of Cattle above 12 months old	1 6
From 10 do. and upwards	9
For each sheep	2
From 100 sheep and upwards	1 1/2
For each pig	5 0
For each goat	1 0

Table of Rates of Sustenance.

For each horse, mare, gelding, mule, ass, poney, or head of horned cattle, except sucking foals and calves, per day	2 0
For every sheep	6
„ goat	6
„ pig	1 0

Such rates of sustenance to be charged for each 24 hours, half rates to be charged for less than 12 hours, and no charge to be made for less than 3 hours.
