**Road between Ellen's Brook and Moore River.**

*Colonial Secretary's Office, Perth,  
9th March, 1863.*

**I**T is hereby notified for general information, that it is the intention of the Government to survey and lay out, as soon as convenient, a line of road between Ellen's Brook and Moore River, with a

view to the same being cleared and opened for use as a public line of communication, pursuant to the provisions of existing Ordinances.

The intended road will be one chain wide, and will pass as near as may be found convenient along the tracks at present in use, commencing where the road to Bindoon strikes off from Karkaby, in Swan location 91. From Karkaby the road will ascend the left bank of Ellen's Brook in a north, north-westerly direction, passing near the N.E. corner of locations 91 and 103 to Chandala Spring, and thence in the same direction through location 203 on left bank of Lennard's Brook. Crossing that Brook at south corner of location 343, it will proceed along the S.W. boundary of the latter to S.W. corner of location 103, then between locations 103 and 351, and in a north-westerly direction through locations 335 and 262 to the present crossing over Gingin Brook between locations 264 and 265. Passing along the west boundary of 264 to its N.W. corner, the road will extend in a more westerly direction to S.W. corner of location 288, and thence true north to N.E. corner of location 361, and north-westerly past W. S. Dewar's location 192, to the intended bridge over Moore River, referred to in a Gazette notice dated 10th May 1862.

Parties are warned against fencing across, or otherwise obstructing the intended road above described.
