PROCLAMATION

By His Excellency John Stephen Hampton, Esquire, Governor, and Commander-in-Chief, in and over the Territory of Western Australia and its Dependencies, and Vice Admiral of the same.

WHEREAS by an Ordinance of the Legislative Council of the said Colony, made and passed in the twenty seventh year of the reign of Her Most Gracious Majesty Queen Victoria, No. 21, entitled "An Ordinance for the recovery of Small Debts and Demands," the Governor is empowered by Proclamation, to constitute Local Courts for the recovery of small debts and demands, to be holden at such times and places, and within such districts throughout the said Colony as may be most convenient. Now therefore, I the said Governor, in exercise of such power, do hereby notify and proclaim, and do hereby constitute Local Courts for the recovery of Small Debts and Demands, to be holden on the second Wednesday in each and every month, at the hour of ten o'clock in the morning, in the following City, Towns, and Districts throughout the Colony, viz. :—
