NOTICE TO MARINERS.

Buoy in Butcher's Inlet, near "Tien Tsin" Harbor, North-West Australia.

The Buoy is placed in mid-channel within the Inlet, opposite the upper part of the first beach, on the North shore, in 26 feet at high water spring tides, and from 5 to 7 feet at low water, giving a berth over a mud bottom free from rocks.

These moorings are only to be used as stern or ebb tide moorings, vessels using their own anchors to seaward or on flood tide.

Masters of vessels are prohibited from using these moorings to swing to, as at single anchor, as the chain would then be displaced and the anchor fouled this, in such a contracted place would tend to mislead a stranger as to the best berth for his vessel to take the ground safely at low water.
