## PROCLAMATION

By His Excellency John Stephen Hampton, Esquire. Governor and Commander-in-Chief in and over the Territory of Western Australia and its Dependencies, and Vice-Admiral of the same.

HEREAS it is enacted by the second Section of the "Small Debts Ordinance, 1863,' that it shall be lawful for the Governor from time to time and at any time by Proclamation published in the Western Australian Government Gazette, to constitute Local Courts for the recovery of Small Debts and Demands to be holden at such times and places and within such districts throughout the said Colony, as may be most fit and convenient, and as may be specified in such Proclamation, and likewise by Proclamation, to alter the time, or place, or manner of holding any such Courts. And that it has been deemed expedient to alter as hereinafter specified the time for holding the Local Court at Bunbury. Now THEREFORE I, the said Governor, in exercise of such power DO HEREBY notify and proclaim that from and after this date the Local Court in the district of Wellington shall be holden at the Police Court in the town of Bunbury on the second Tuesday in each month.
