**Road between Dunnsbro' and Cape
Naturaliste.**

IT is hereby notified that, as soon as practicable, a line of public road, half a chain in width, will be laid out and declared between the South boundary of Dunnsbro' Townsite and Bunker Bay to the eastward of Cape Naturaliste.

The said road will be in continuation of that already laid out near the shore between Busselton and Dunnsbro', and will pass as near as may be found desirable along the track now in use.

Commencing on the shore of Geographe Bay, near Sussex location 44, it will take a north-westerly direction to near the centre of Dunnsbro', then diverge to the West by North, pass through location 70 in a northerly direction, along the west side of the land at present fenced within that location, and thence pass about North by West to location **d** on the shore of Bunker Bay.
