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PROCLAMATION.

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By His Excellency John Stephen Hampton, Esquire, Governor and Commander-in-Chief in and over the Territory of Western Australia and its Dependencies, and Vice-Admiral of the same.

Ordinances were passed by me the said Governor, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council of the said Colony, in the 29th year of the reign of Her Majesty Queen Victoria, and respectively entitled:—

No. 10.—"An Ordinance to confirm the Expenditure for the services of the year 1864 beyond the grant for that year."

No. 11.—"An Ordinance to appropriate the sum of Seventy Six Thousand and Fifty Nine Pounds out of the General Revenue of the Colony for the service of the year One Thousand Eight Hundred and Sixty Six."

No. 12.—"An Ordinance to incorporate the Governors of the Perth Church of England Collegiate School"

Now THEREFORE I, the said Governor do hereby proclaim and make known to all whom it may concern, that Her Majesty has been graciously pleased to confirm and allow the same.
