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PROCLAMATION.

By His Excellency John Stephen Hampton, Esquire, Governor and Commander-in-Chief in and over the Territory of Western Australia and its Dependencies, and Vice-Admiral of the same.

WHEREAS by a Proclamation given at Government House, at Perth, under my hand and the Public Seal, on the 17th day of January, 1865, certain Regulations for the disposal of the Waste Crown Lands in the Northern District of Western Australia were proclaimed and issued with the sanction of Her Majesty's Secretary of State for the Colonies, *And Whereas* such Regulations admitted of the acquisition of such Crown Lands upon certain favorable terms within twelve calendar months from the said 17th day of January, 1865. *And Whereas* Her Majesty's said Principal Secretary of State for the Colonies has, upon my representation, extended such period of twelve months for a further period of One year, NOW THEREFORE I, the said Governor, pursuant to the authority in me vested in that behalf do hereby proclaim and make known, that the period within which Land in the Northern District of the said Colony may be acquired on the exceptional terms mentioned in the said Regulations has been extended for One year which will expire on the 17th day of January, 1867.
