Road between York and Chauncy's Road.

THE undermentioned Branch Road having recently been Surveyed and laid out, it is hereby declared to be a public line of Road, in terms of existing Ordinances.

The road is 33 feet wide, on the north side of the following lines, which are marked at their respective angles of meeting by squared and pointed posts.

Commencing at a spot on the western boundary of York Townsite 2 chains 97 links NNW from its south corner, the road extends 41 chains 30 links in direction South 85 degrees West to the west boundary of Avon location Y 19, then 9 chains 76 links South 52 degrees West, and 19 chains 12 links South 58 degrees 48 minutes West, and 5 chains 56 links South 71 degrees 40 minutes West, and 5 chains 54 links South 88 degrees 20 minutes

West, and 2 chains 16 links South 78 degrees West, and 2 chains 68 links South 69 degrees West, and 13 chains 35 links South 81 degrees West, and 10 chains 68 links South 69¼ degrees West to the west boundary of location Y 17, then 15 chains 92 links South 71 degrees West, to the west boundary of location 47, and finally 5 chains 15 links South 67 degrees 37 minutes West, one chain wide to the public road gazetted on the 9th day of December, 1847;—all bearings being magnetic.

IT is hereby notified for general information that Her Majesty's Postmaster General has concluded a new Contract with the P. & O. Company for the Mail Service between the United Kingdom and India and China.

Commencing next month, the Indian Mails are to be despatched from London on a fixed day in every week, and Mails for Point de Galle and China will be made up with the Indian Mails in every alternate week.

With every alternate Mail to Point de Galle Mails for the several Australian Colonies will be despatched from London, so that Australian Mails will be made up once in four weeks instead of once in a Calendar Month as at present.

The return Mails for England will, in like manner, be made up in Australia on fixed days in every fourth week, instead of on certain days of the month.

Consequent on these changes it will be necessary to alter the time of departure from this Office of the European and Colonial Mails, and the next Mails will accordingly be despatched at the undermentioned dates, respectively, viz. :—

Mails for the Australian Colonies, New Zealand, and Tasmania on Saturday the 1st prox., at 10 o'clock a.m.

Mails for the United Kingdom, Continent of Europe, India, &c., &c., on Thursday the 6th prox., at 10 o'clock a.m.

Registered Letters for transmission by the above Mails must be posted One hour before the time of closing, and late letters, if stamped with a late fee, will be received up to 12-30 p.m. of the respective mail days. Money Orders on the Australian Colonies and New Zealand will be issued up to 11 o'clock a.m. on Thursday the 30th instant, and on the United Kingdom up to 11 o'clock a.m. on Monday the 3rd proximo.

Due Notice will be given to the Public of the days fixed for the departure of future Mails.
