Road between York and Chauncy's Road.

THE undermentioned Branch Road having recently been Surveyed and laid out, it is hereby declared to be a public line of Road, in terms of existing Ordinances.

The road is 33 feet wide, on the north side of the following lines, which are marked at their respective angles of meeting by squared and pointed posts.

Commencing at a spot on the western boundary of York Townsite 2 chains 97 links NNW from its south corner, the road extends 41 chains 30 links in direction South 85 degrees West to the west boundary of Avon location Y 19, then 9 chains

76 links South 52 degrees West, and 19 chains 12 links South 58 degrees 48 minutes West, and 5 chains 56 links South 71 degrees 40 minutes West, and 5 chains 54 links South 88 degrees 20 minutes West, and 2 chains 16 links South 78 degrees West, and 2 chains 68 links South 69 degrees West, and 13 chains 35 links South 81 degrees West, and 10 chains 68 links South 69 $\frac{1}{4}$ degrees West to the west boundary of location Y 17, then 15 chains 92 links South 71 degrees West, to the west boundary of location 47, and finally 5 chains 15 links South 67 degrees 37 minutes West, one chain wide to the public road gazetted on the 9th day of December, 1847;—all bearings being magnetic.
